

Kechi found her true voice after her accident; a plane crash that took the lives of 107 of 109 passengers in Nigeria in 2005. Throughout the difficult journey of burns recovery, Kechi was sustained by her faith, her family and her music. She graduated Summa Cum Laude in 2015 with a BBA in Economics, then began performing at her church, at burn galas and family events, sharing what she loved with those she loved. She started her MBA in 2016, the same year she was discovered by America's Got Talent.

Becoming a finalist on AGT was Kechi's dream realized. She has since become a burns advocate and ambassador, as well as an inspirational speaker and singer, and she has chosen to forge ahead on a path that allows her to explore both business and artistic opportunities.
